Four local parishes—St. Jude, St. Mary, Holy Spirit, and Holy Family—have again organized two tour buses (~112 seats) to go to the March for Life in D.C. on Friday, January 27th. Since we have raised enough money to pay for the buses, seats on the buses are free and are assigned on a first-come basis. We ask that those who indicate an interest in going must make every effort to avoid backing out at the last minute because every seat left open is one that someone else could have taken. As to schedule, the buses will leave from St. Jude at 6:00am on the 27th and will make a second pickup at about 6:15 at the park & ride at the 118 exit off of I-81/US 460. Arrival in D.C. is expected to be at about 11:30am and departure at about 4:30pm. We encourage people to bring their own lunches and any snacks that they may want. Dinner will be at about 6pm at the Cracker Barrel off of the Woodstock exit of I-81. Arrival back at the stops in Christiansburg and Radford will be between 10pm and 11pm.
