### ALTERNATIVE SPRING BREAK WITH THE NEWMAN OUTREACH PROJECT

“Alternative Spring Break is something that I heard frequently around Newman and didn't fully understand, other than you and a group of fellow Catholic Hokies travel to another state for a week to do service. ASB is more than a week of service, it's about taking a step back and fully seeing God in another community and learning and interacting with/from people in your group, as well as every single person you encounter that week. I interviewed for a trip thinking if nothing else I'll get more involved with Newman and I'll be able to help someone through a physical task or just being there to talk with them.

My experience in Lima, Ohio was so much more than that. I got to be a part of a community where people turned to God and lived His will to the fullest, whether they were going through a rough patch in their personal lives or decided their mission was to help other people see God's glory through different ministries such as soup kitchens, habitat for humanity restores, crisis centers, and programs for high school youth. Alternative Spring Break was such an eye-opening experience and a week that I will never forget because of the relationships that were created and strengthened with God and those around me.”

“The Newman Outreach Project exposed me to a whole new kind of community service: that is, service that extends beyond my immediate community. It is easy to focus on the day-to-day problems of myself and those around me, but I forget that there are entire communities around the nation and across the world that are in much more dire circumstances than myself. The Alternate Spring Break trip allowed me to provide tangible service to a soup kitchen, men's shelter, abused women's shelter, Habitat for Humanity Restore, and food banks in Lima, Ohio. But more importantly, I learned about the community of Lima and the passion its residents have for their history and their hope to turn a community hit hard by the economy back into the thriving city it used to be. Some of the best moments were the greetings and smiles and stories we got from Lima residents, the memories of which will last much longer than the tangible service we completed. I hope I left a lasting impact on the community of Lima; I know I will never forget the wonderful people I met.”
