January 21st and 22nd, the first days of the semester, the Newman Community will be joining the Diocese of Richmond at the March for Life in Washington, D.C. This march commemorates the landmark Supreme Court decision in Roe vs. Wade legalizing abortion in all states in the U.S. Every year hundreds of thousands gather to voice their belief that all life is sacred. The cost is \$20, and registration is due by **Sunday, December 15th at 10pm!** If you would like to register, stop by the Newman House with \$20 or sign up after any of the Sunday Masses. Tuesday, January 21st (1st day of Spring Semester)

Wednesday, January 22nd

Rally and Mass at the Patriot Center, then on to the March for Life at the Washington Memorial. At the conclusion of the March for Life, board buses and travel back to VT.
