"Alternative Spring Break is something that I heard frequently around Newman and didn't fully understand, other than you and a group of fellow Catholic Hokies travel to another state for a week to do service. ASB is more than a week of service, it's about taking a step back and fully seeing God in another community and learning and interacting with/from people in your group, as well as every single person you encounter that week. I interviewed for a trip thinking if nothing else I'll get more involved with Newman and I'll be able to help someone through a physical task or just being there to talk with them.

My experience in Lima, Ohio was so much more than that. I got to be a part of a community where people turned to God and lived His will to the fullest, whether they were going through a rough patch in their personal lives or decided their mission was to help other people see God's glory through different ministries such as soup kitchens, habitat for humanity restores, crisis centers, and programs for high school youth. Alternative Spring Break was such an eye-opening experience and a week that I will never forget because of the relationships that were created and strengthened with God and those around me."
