

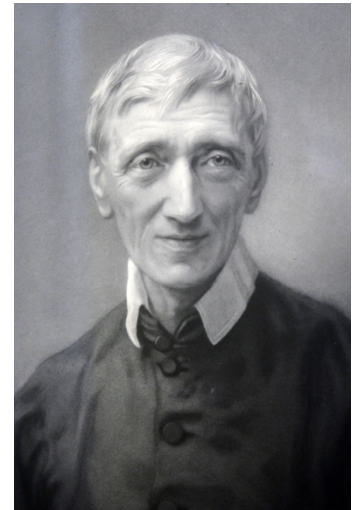

Canonization of St. John Henry Cardinal Newman!

Sunday, October 13th, is the canonization day of St. John Henry Cardinal Newman, the patron of the Catholic community here and on many campuses throughout the world! St. John Newman was a theologian, philosopher, and cardinal who converted to Catholicism. He was an Anglican priest at Oxford University for many years, and had an influential role in the "Oxford Movement," a movement in the High Anglican Church to move back towards the fundamentals of their faith (very similar to Catholicism). Throughout this movement Newman became convinced in the authority of the Pope, and converted to Catholicism, later becoming ordained a Catholic priest. His devotion to the University is seen even today through the many "Newman Communities" founded on college campuses throughout the world. Today is a special day for our community, so come celebrate with us! Our Masses this weekend will be a celebration of his feast day, we will have some special prayer cards printed, and we will have a very nice Sunday Supper to celebrate!
